Application Guidelines of the General International Competition

1. Theme

Becoming Place through Events

If you successfully create something new by drawing out the virtualities of the land and various external variables of society and by applying the appropriate parts to the context, it means that the virtual flowing behind the site has been successfully actualized. Depending on the degree of creation, infinite virtualities connects and changes like a continuously flowing sensation. 'What should be the methodology that can express the sense of place architecturally?' Developing a sense for this will become the sense of architecture that understands and implements the place. It will inevitably be a place where the desires and needs of those who enjoy the place are actualized through various connections.

After passing through the dark tunnel of the pandemic period, we need a solution that can transcend the existing uniformity, standardization, and partitioned space and society. It is time to consider ways to enable more people to communicate smoothly, realize new virtualities, and satisfy local specialties along with universality.

As mentioned above, the 40th Busan International Architectural Competition has the theme of presenting alternatives to a place of becoming that blends locality while being full of virtualities after the pandemic through 'Becoming Place through Events'.

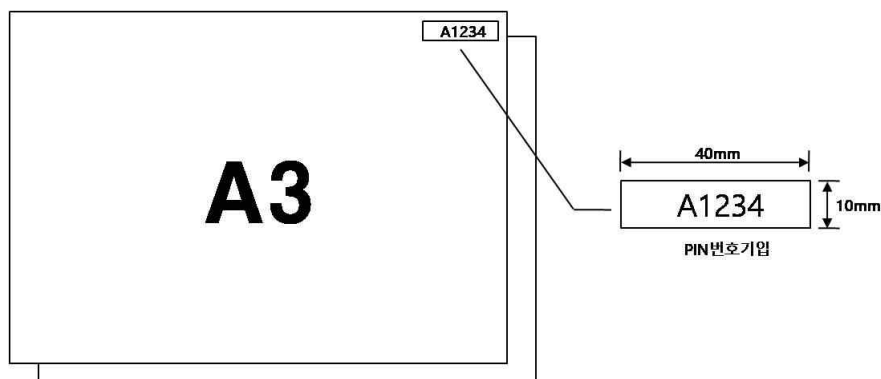

15. Guidelines for Submission

- 15.1. The 1st Work Submission(Submission by e-mail)
- 1) Submittal Size A3(width 420mm × length 297mm)
- Use pictures, photographs, sketches, texts, etc. to construct the work freely while focusing on the expression of the concept (Instead of expressing the final output, focus on the issues and directions for their resolution in terms of architecture).
 - Include provisional concepts, master plan, the picture of a study model, and other images.
 - Write down the PIN number inside a table at the top right side of both pieces of A3 paper (width 40 mm x length 10 mm). The PIN number shall be randomly selected by the applicant as shown in the example below, and shall consist of one alphabet (capitalized) as the first digit and four Arabic numbers as the remaining digits. The PIN number shall not include any other password or symbol, and any submission that violates this rule will be excluded from the review.

- The theme for the panel, model, and target plot submitted for the 2nd Review shall be the same as the 1st work.
- The front or back of the printed work shall be free of any indication (school name, class, name, etc.) which can be used to identify the applicant.
- All renditions, such as the color and material of the file, method of expression, or order of the presentation shall be chosen freely by the applicant.

15.2. The 2nd Work Submission(Submission by e-mail and open only for those who passed the 1st Review)

- 1) Submittal Size A0(width 900mm × length 1200mm)
 - The construction of the 2nd work should be the detailed development of the 1st work.
 - Construct the contents with graphics and texts(in English only).
 - Write down the PIN number on the table at the top right side of the panel (width 40mm x length 10 mm) as per the 1st Work Submission. The PIN number shall match the PIN number chosen for the 1st Work Submission.
- 2) Description of the work(Form 1)
 - Articulate ideas for the design of the work within two pages of A4 paper (excluding the cover).
 - The description of the work must be written in English only.
- 3) Digital documents (Submission by e-mail)
 - ① Panel image (JPEG/300dpi) file
 - ② Description of the work (hwp or doc file)
 - ③ Freestyle photo of the applicant's upper body (JPEG)

15.3. Submission of the materials for the The 3rd Review and open presentation(Applicable only for those who passed the 2nd evaluation)

- 1) Produce a 5-minutes recorded video presentation, presented in the English language.
- 2) Submit the material via email (kiabcompe@naver.com) by 17:00 Friday, September 24, and any modification or change to the submitted files will not be allowed.
- 3) The files should be saved mp4. or avi.

15.4. Model: Each presenter subject to the 3rd open presentation should submit a model that fully satisfies the criteria specified below, and the model must be included in the presentation video.

- The model should be freely expressed within a volume (space) of 650mm (width) X 450 mm (length) X 400mm (height).
- For submission, the bottom of the model should be attached to a 50mm woodrock or foam board, but not ISO pink.
- The submitted works shall be physically sturdy to prevent any damage before or after the review, and shall be able to be displayed of their own accord (without any supportive structure). Up to three surfaces are allowed to be displayed while one surface shall be set as the default surface for display.
- Overseas applicants shall submit their works by placing up to four pictures of the model (jpg 300dpi) on a paper sized 900mm × 600mm.

15.5. General guidelines

- 1) The official languages are Korean and English. However, presenter must only use the English language in the presentations for the 3rd Review.
- 2) Measurements shall be made using the Metric System.

16. Copyright

- 17.1. The copyrights of the submitted works belong to the applicant.
- 17.2. The rights to publish or present works belong to the host (KIA Busan).

17. Other rules

- 17.1. All submitted materials except for the application forms shall not be marked with any indication of the identity of the applicant (school, name, class, etc.).
- 17.2. Works previously presented or submitted for other competitions will be disqualified for reviews.
- 17.3. Except for the stated rules and answers to the questions, the applicant shall be free to interpret any aspect of this competition.
- 17.4. Registration fees are not refundable.
- 17.5. The materials submitted for the 1st work submissions will not be returned.
- 17.6. Questions/answers and other inquiries can be posted only through the question board of the competition's website. Questions concerning the subject/theme shall be posted openly by the applicants and will not be accepted outside a specified period.
- 17.8. Additional registration may be available if the applicant fails to register due to the apparent negligence of the hosts or due to other natural disasters, or if the general competition Steering Committee acknowledges the need for additional registrations.
- 17.9. Works deemed unsuitable to comply with the specifications and regulations for the submission shall be excluded from the review.
- 17.10. Applicants shall be careful not to be disadvantaged by any changes that any applicants do not notice, as all changes and updates related to the competition will be regularly published on the notice board of the competition website. In particular, notice may be posted on the website through pop-up windows, so applicants should ensure that their computers do not block pop-up notifications.
- 17.11. Matters that are not stated in these guidelines shall be addressed in accordance with the decisions made by the Steering Committee of the Busan International Architecture Competition for this year.
